International training course "Participation laboratory: using Erasmus Plus projects to promote real Participation" is a 7 day training course, which will be implemented by partners from Norway, Belarus, Ukraine, Lithuania, Latvia, Armenia and Poland. The training course will be implemented in Lithuania from 14th to 21th of March, 2017. The project aims to develop youth worker competencies of youth workers to ensure better quality in Erasmus+ projects.

## Aim:

To provide beginner youth workers with project management competencies to empower them to tackle new European challenges youth radicalism.

## **Objectives:**

- 1. Train participants how to use youth projects as a tool to work with marginalized and unemployed youth;
- 2. Develop youth worker project development, project administration competencies and raise their awareness on quality criteria of youth projects.
- 3. Create new international partnerships and create ideas for future projects on topics of youth unemployment, working with marginalized and fewer opportunity youth.
- 4. Provide participants with practical tools to assure project quality into the following aspects: dissemination and exploitation of results, equal partnership, non-formal education, inter cultural learning, active participation of youth.

## **Conditions:**

Lodging and food is covered during the project. Travel costs will be reimbursed according to Erasmus+ rules (the maximum travel allowance for Armenia is 360 Eur).
