You will have accommodation at a university dormitory, which is located in the city centre of Szeged. Each room has more beds, so you will have to share your room with other volunteers. Additional information



Tickets of public transport, food costs and pocket money will be provided according to the regulations of the Erasmus +. If the volunteers want to get to know the country deeper, they have to provide it from their own money. The volunteers will get 2 days holiday. The office functions as the main workstation, and has internet connection and mutual kitchen. After the selection process and former arrangements, volunteers have to purchase their travelling tickets. After arrival, Talentum will reimburse the travelling expenses if all tickets are saved. CIGNA insurance will be effected by the sending organisation. Accident-ticket should be fixed by the volunteer.
