PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Whit this project we want to encourage young people to take an active part in their life through stimulating their sense of entrepreneurship and creativity.

The project will be implemented through the method of non-formal education and experiential learning, using workshop, interactive activities and role play games we'll give a direct experience to the participants of situations they may face in the future in their job or student careers. The project will gather 42 young people coming from 7 different countries. Participants will have the chance to know more about traditions and culture of other countries, the program of the project itself moreover will give them the opportunity to live in diverse group, develop tolerance, mutual understanding and co-operation.

ABOUT US:

OTHERSIDE is an organization for social development founded in 2015 . The decision to found the association was taken by a group of young people with many experiences in initiatives under Erasmus+ programme and local volunteering,

Encouraging and promoting active citizenship we try as much as we can to lead young people to be masters of their own future .

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES: ■ The project is divided into two main sections, both of them ■ linked to creativity and entrepreneurship, trying to approach these topics from different perspectives. ■

The first part of the project will be aimed to develop and encourage creativity and self-confidence, while the second part of the project will be more focused on entrepreneurial sector, with the main aim to give the participants useful knowledge and skills about how to realize and promote an entrepreneurial or business idea. This part will also be focused on United Nations 17 World Goals for sustainable development.

WORKING METHOD:

Our youth exchange will be based on non - formal learning process. It means that learning is based on your experience, your motivation and your needs. During the project non - formal education methods and methods, and methods that assure balance between theory and practice will be used such as: workshops, presentations, co - operative games, individual work, small discussion groups, plenary work, group dynamics, personal challenges, theoretical input .

DATES AND VENUE:

Arrival of participants: 12th September

Activities starts: 13th September

Activities end: 21th September

Departure day: 22nd September



The project will take place in Mosciano Sant'Angelo, a little town 5km far from the Adriatic coast in the Italian countryside. Participants will be accommodated in 3 and 4 bed-rooms.

Accommodation and food during the days of the project are 100% covered by the hosting organization. There will be 3 meals and 2 coffee breaks every day.

Of course we will keep an eye on the needs of people with allergies and vegetarians and so on. Near the hotel there is plenty of space where to do outdoor activities.

TRAVEL COST:

We will reimburse 100% of participant's travel costs from your home town to the project venue, within the valid budget sums. (The sums for travel costs are calculated according to the official rules for Erasmus+ programme, where considering the distance. All limits can be calculated according to the distance calculator: http://ec.europa.eu/dgs/education_culture/tools/distance_en.htm)

Note: Travel expenses exceeding the stated costs limit will be reimbursed only till the amount of the limit, the excess will be paid by participant himself/herself.

Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all (including return) original tickets, receipts/invoices and boarding passes and later sending of the return documents and boarding passes. You must use public transport (bus, metro, tram) – taxi will not be reimbursed! Please keep the boarding passes from your airport check-in as well. Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

PARTICIPANTS:

- Participants are expected to be:
- Between 19 – 25 years old (No age limit for the group leader);
- Motivated to work directly with young people on project issues;
- Able to work and communicate in english;
- Able to attend the full duration of the project;
- Energetic, cheerful and creative!

PREPARATION:

Little Homework: Participants will prepare before the Youth Exchange a brief presentation about:

- Difficulties and opportunities for young entrepreneurs in the country of origin;
- Situation of sustainable entrepreneurship at local level;
- Activities of the sending NGOs made in recent years to improve, promote and inform young entrepreneurs in the local community;

Individual preparation: Each participant will be required to bring his own CV .

Intercultural night: There will be intercultural night, where every country will present its culture . Do not forget to bring some traditional music, food, drinks and other stuff representing your country and culture in some way .

Activity preparation: Each national team will be required to prepare two activities (simulations, workshops, brainstorming ecc .) for the group . More details about the context and the activities to prepare will be shared once the group is complete .

YOUTHPASS:

Every participant is individually entitled to receive a **Youthpass certificate**, which confirms participation and validates the non-formal learning (NFL) experience of the Youth Exchange project. The Youthpass is an official recognition and validation of the learning experiences of participants, moreover participants can benefit of this document in terms of the educational or future employment opportunities. Through Youthpass the European Commission ensures that the Youth Exchange activity is recognized as a non-formal learning experience.
