

Erasmus+ Training Course on Improvisation & Entrepreneurial mindset

5th — 13th February 2019 (including arrival and departure days)

Kobuleti, Georgia

Context



Being part of the dynamically changing labour market, the new generations of youth are facing different challenges nowadays, when they are at the start of their careers. New needs and structure of the labour market appeared while the structure of the formal education remained the same. Thus, sense of initiative, creativity and entrepreneurialmindset have become extremely important.

In this training course, we will tackle the topic of youth entrepreneurship, their first involvement and necessary soft skills in this field.

The aim is to introduce applied improvisation and empower youth workers to apply it to increase the sense of youth entrepreneurship. We will explore attitudes of entrepreneurship, such as taking risk, creativity, problemsolving, sense of initiative, working with mistakes and other essential skills for young people.

This will help to prepare young people to get successfully engaged with the labour market, perceive their life as from entrepreneurs' perspective, learn from each experience and take these into their local communities.

Objectives

- to develop social skills, improve sense of initiative and entrepreneurship through applied improvisation
- to provide a space for sharing best practices focusing on using non - formal educational methods in the field of youth work
- to introduce Youthpass as a tool for self assessment evaluation and recognition of non - formal learning
- to foster international cooperation between European, Caucasian and Eastern partnership regions and their neighbouring countries

Implementation

The project will be practical, active and experiential as well as theoretical. The aim is to equip each partner with necessary tools and knowledge needed to be used and disseminate the gained knowledge within their organizations. By doing so, each partner will contribute to the inclusion of the underprivileged youth in their country.



Who are we looking for?



Youth workers, youth leaders, trainers, mentors, members and volunteers of youth organizations.

We expect participants that work with youngsters on local, national or/and international level and are eager to learn something new, contribute their experience and knowledge and are playful, active and simply believe in the power of non-formal education.

Venue

All the participants are expected to stay and actively participate the whole time of the TC.

The program will be in Kobuleti, a town located in Adjara region of Georgia. Kobuleti is situated at the Black Sea, about 130 km from Kutaisi, where the nearest airport is located. More detailed information on how to reach the place will be included in the infopack that will be sent to participants after their acceptance.
