Short Description of the Project

In the news every day we are encountered by hundreds of headlines loaded with the messages related to conflict, troubles, confrontation, opposition, war... and on the background of these messages we often hear other exclamations: immigration, extremism, Islamism, terrorism. A huge number of them refer to Europe and the European Union.

In view of this the necessity arouse to conduct a training course on conflict resolution for persons involved in the work with youth.

Objectives of the TC:

- to exchange experiences and raise awareness about understanding the conflict, its roots, types and different levels where conflicts can occur;
- to discuss the notion of conflict in the framework of human rights;
- to exchange information about participants' realities and to raise participants awareness about some current conflicts in Europe and analyze the effect that these involuntary cause in other countries;

- to help participants develop competences needed for using different tools for conflict resolution, to provide them with different tools of conflict resolution, to develop skills of negotiations as one of the ways of conflict resolution;
- to develop new initiatives for and with young people for addressing conflicts on different levels.

Learning outcomes of the TC:

- acquire the theoretical, as well as practical knowledge about the types of conflicts, stages, causes, sources and strategies of conflict management and conflict resolution;
- improving communication skills both in their native language and in foreign languages;
- getting to know various negotiation strategies and seeing how this method can be very effective when dealing with conflicts.
- gaining knowledge about simulation games and informal methods of education;
- improving collaboration abilities with people from different cultural backgrounds and people of different nationalities.
- · improving digital competences.

Participants profile

Number of participants from each country: 3 people (Ukraine and Germany – 4 persons)

Age: 18+

Involvement in the youth work (Ex. Youth leader, youth worker, worker in the youth NGO, student organization, etc.)
Sufficient knowledge of the English language (B1-B2 level)

Methodology used

During the activity the following methods will be used: icebreakers, name games, getting-to-know each other games, teambuilding and integration activities, simulation and role games, development of the games.

The program will also include the presentation of the programme, discussion of the expectations of participants from the TC, presentation of Erasmus +, introduction to YouthPass, presentations of organizations of participants, planing of follow-up activities and evaluation

Crossing the border and identification in Ukraine

For traveling to Ukraine you need to have <u>international passport</u>. Please, keep it in mind and do not forget to take it, your ID card will not be enough. Good news - for participants from all participating countries is visa-free.

Location





Ukraine is the world's 44th-largest country and the biggest country in Europe. It is located in the very heart of Europe (with Europe's geographical center near the town of Rakhiv, Trans-Carpathian oblast). It is a state in Eastern Europe bordered by Russia to the north and east, Belarus to the north-west, Poland and Slovakia to the west, Hungary, Romania and Moldova to the southwest. The state border extends for a total of 7,590 km. The length of the Ukraine's Sea Coast is 1,959 km. Ukraine is divided into twenty four regions (oblasts) and one autonomous republic

Krym (Crimea). The country has many different geographic area types. In the South Ukraine is washed by the Black Seaand Azov



Sea. There are Carpathian Mountains in the West (the highest point is Mt. Hoverla (2,061 meters) and the Crimean Mountains (the highest point is Roman Kosh (1,545 meters) in the South of the country on the territory of Crimean peninsula. With all of this variation Ukraine is rich with natural beauty. Although the capital of the

country is Kyiv, there are many other large cities spread throughout the country such as Odessa, Lviv, Dniepropetrovsk, Donetsk, Kharkiv, Lugansk, Kryvyi Rih and others. Ukraine is very rich in old world culture. With many forms of art and architecture visible throughout the country, it is easy to find something of interest no matter where you

are. Ukrainian customs are heavily influenced by Christianity, which is the dominant religion in the country. The culture of Ukraine has been also influenced by its eastern and western neighbors, which is reflected in its architecture, music and art. The Communist era had quite a strong effect on the art and writing of Ukraine. http://bestofukraine.com

Slavsko (Slavske)

Slavsko is currently the most popular Carpathian ski resort. It attracts tourists so much because of its low prices and closeness to the big Ukrainian cities. It is situated about 130 km from Lviv and it is easy to get there by train. Slavsko is very conveniently located on the Kiev-Uzhorod rail road.



Travel Costs

The organizers will reimburse 100% of participants' travel costs from your home city to Slavske, Ukraine (Note! Provided that the travel costs do no exceed those designated individually according to the country. Please see the table below to check for the exact amount)

Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all (including return) original tickets, receipt/invoices and boarding passes and later sending of the return documents and boarding passes. Please, be aware that in case you will miss any invoices or tickets we will not be able to reimburse them.

Please, keep the boarding passes from your airport check in as well. Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice according to the official currency exchange rate of European Commission.

!!! Note: Please check the travel budget limits below. If your travel costs exceed the amount budgeted in the project, we will be able to reimburse you only the amount of the travel costs indicated in the travel budget.

Reimbursement of travel costs for participants from EU countries will be done via a bank transfer to the bank account provided to us upon the receipt of the original travel documents.

Reimbursement of travel costs for participants from non-EU countries will be done in cash during the seminar upon the receipt of the original travel documents.
